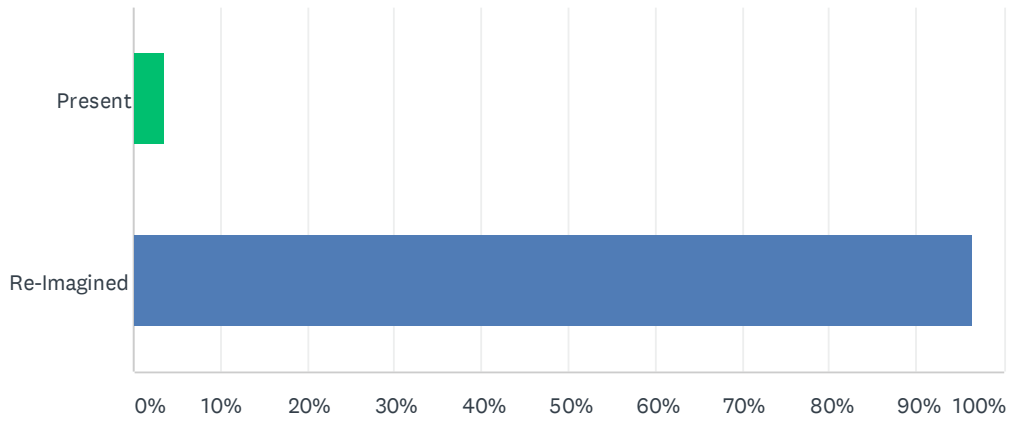


Q1 Wornall Road (Crown Hill - Lodwick) | Choose your preferred.

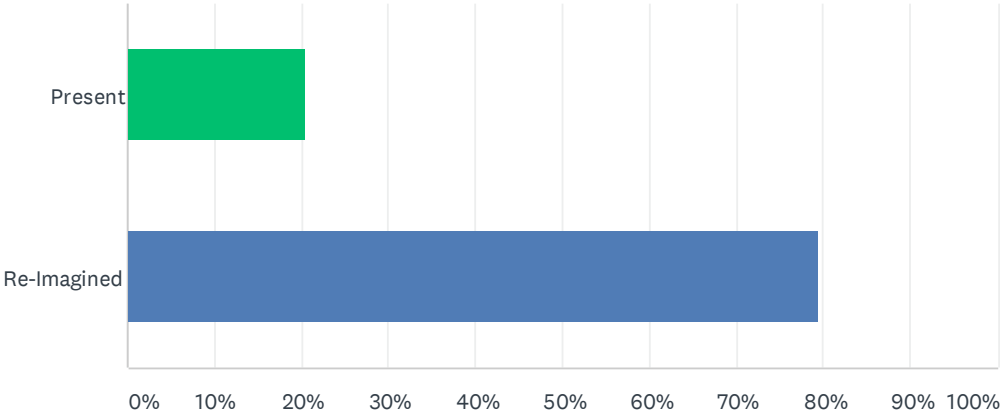

Q2 Wornall Rd. & McCleary Rd. Intersection | Choose your preferred.

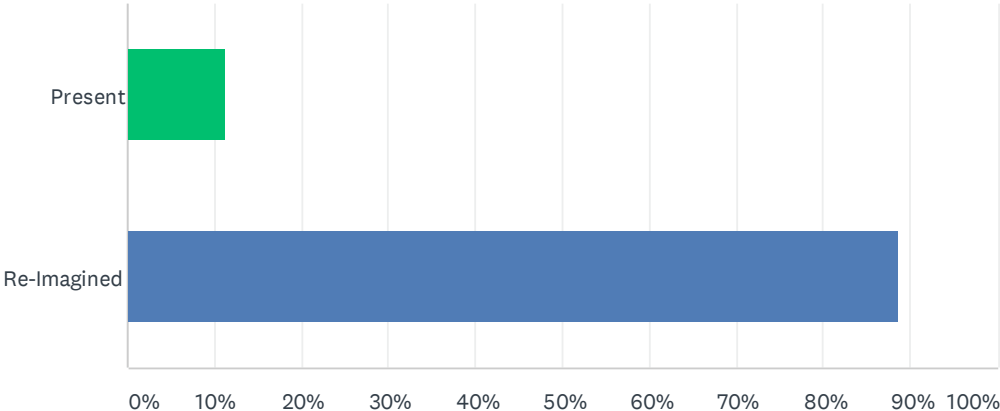

Q3 Westside Business District | Choose your preferred.

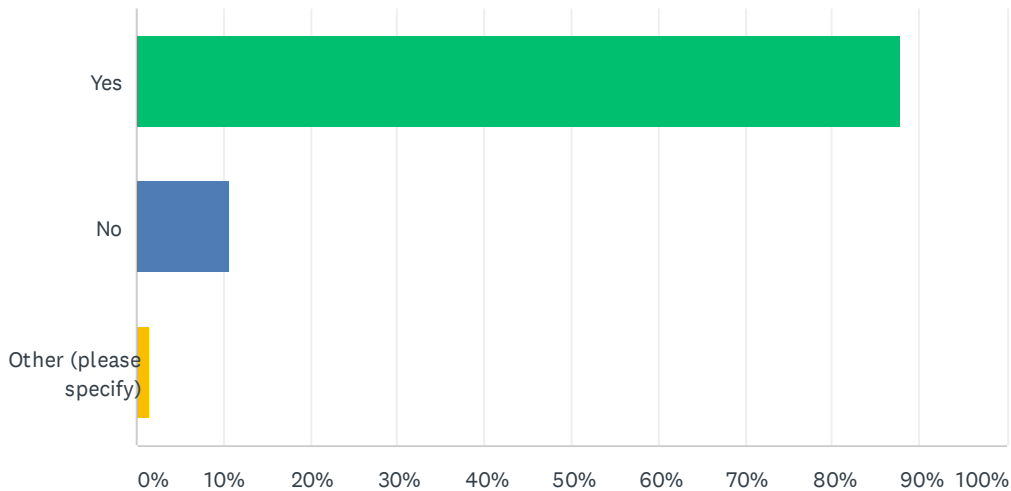

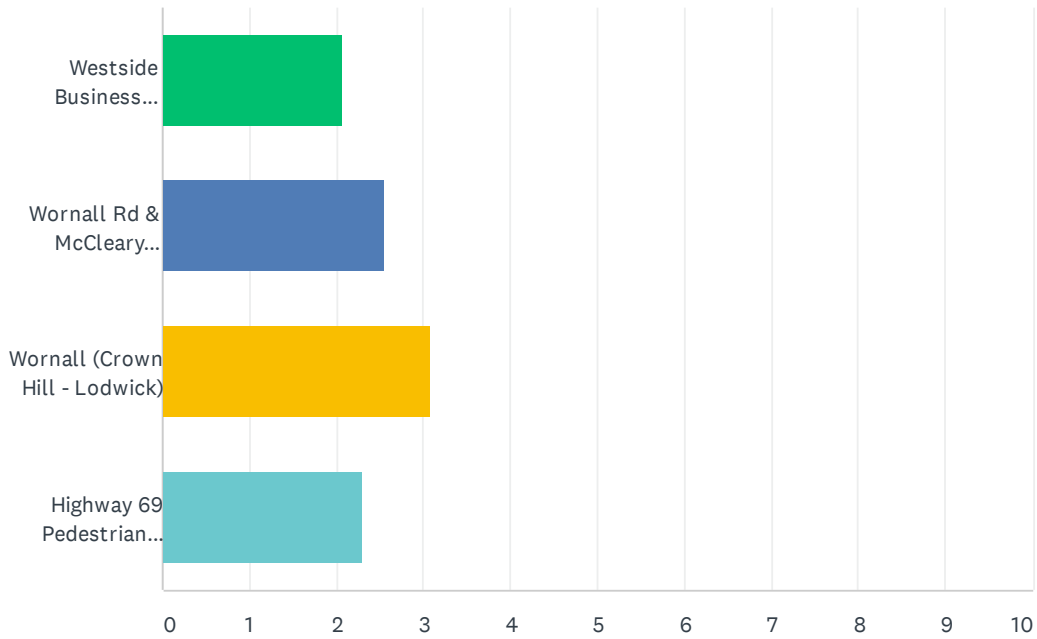

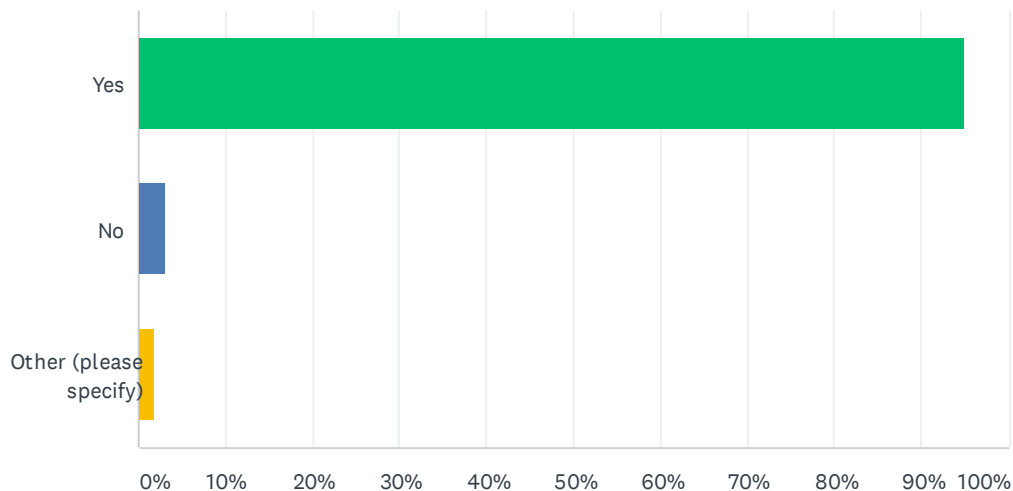

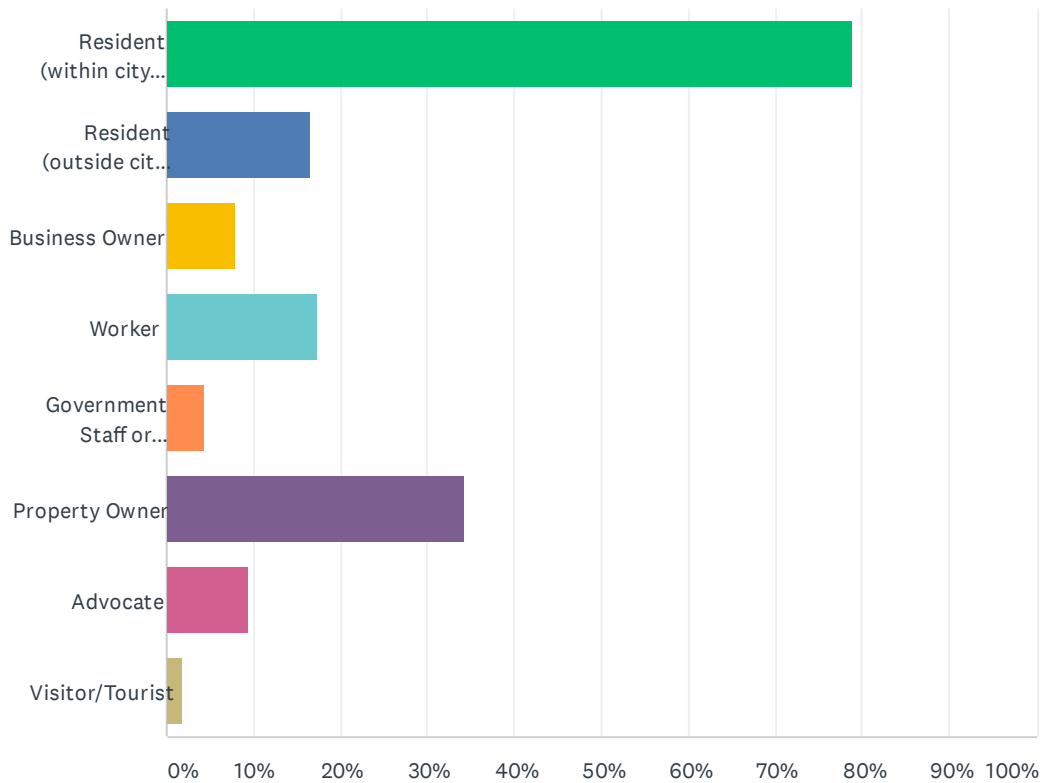

Q8 How would you describe your relationship to Excelsior Springs? Select all that apply.

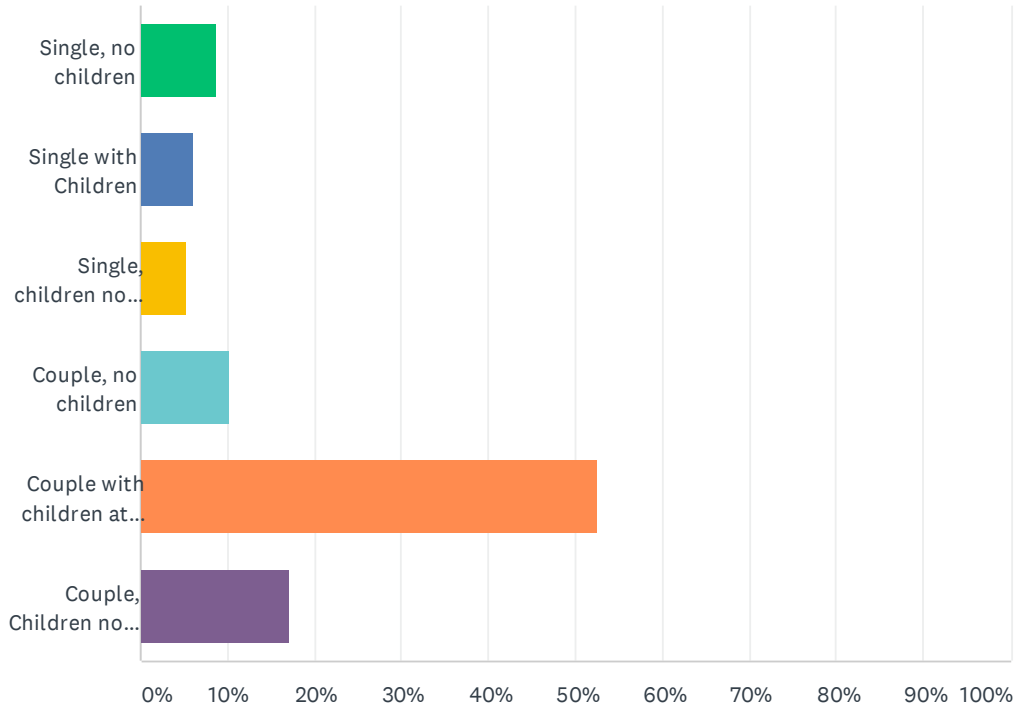

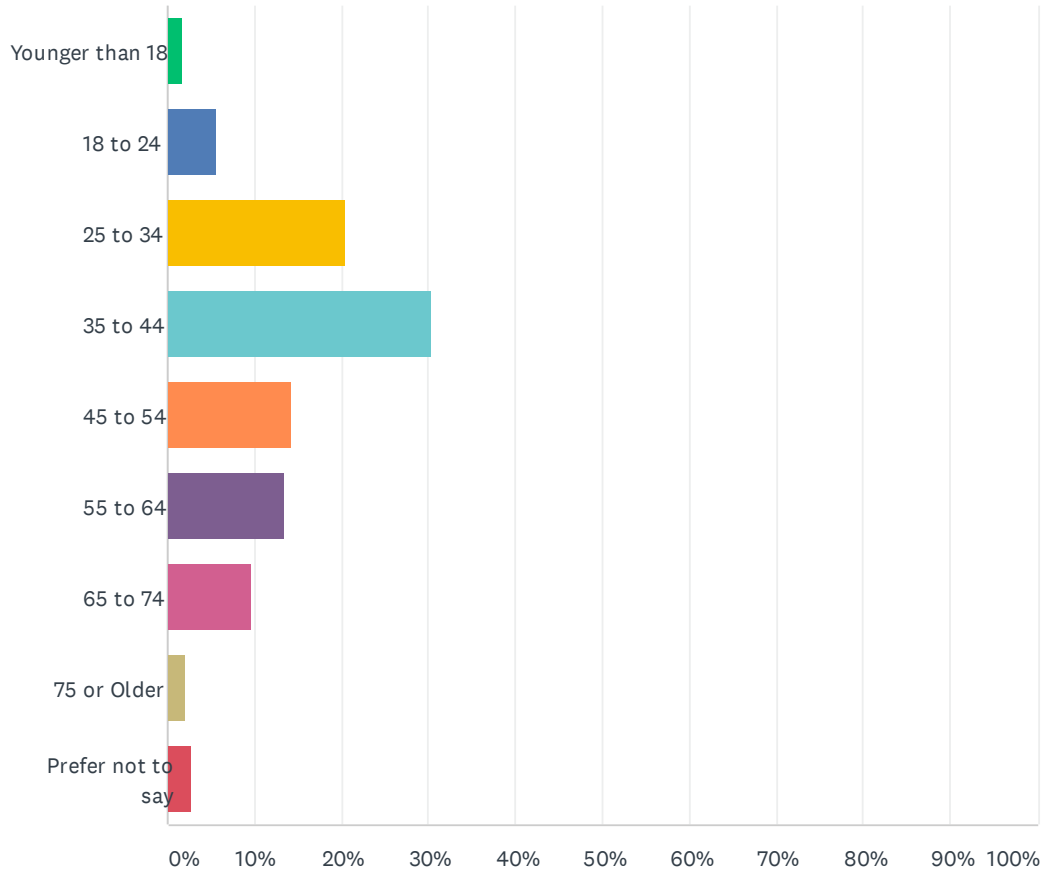

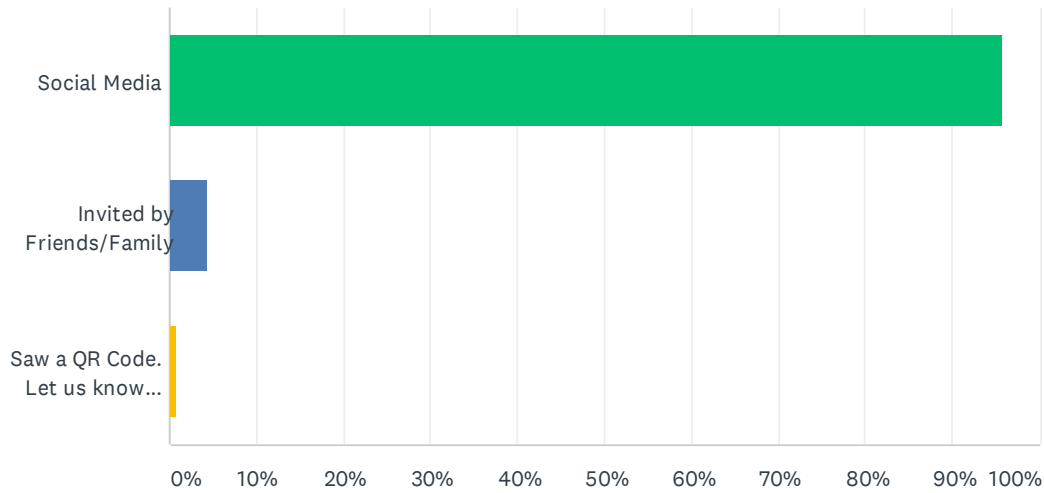
